**Subject: Enduro Championship Scoring System**

For 2011, changes had been made to the scoring system for the Mike Stott UBS Financial Endurance Series. These changes had been made to simplify the points systems and to focus on fair competition on the race track.

However, through our own observations and competitor feedback, we find that this simple system is not totally in keeping with the true Vintage spirit of the joy competing, not just winning. We feel that allotting points to *all* competitors that are classified as “Finishers” will reflect that Vintage spirit.

[This change will be retro-active to the first SVRA event and will not affect the current Point Standings of competitors, what so ever.](#)

Updates to the Endurance Points System:

For 2011, the Championship will include 7 SVRA Enduro events  
Points will be awarded for finishing places 1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> in class

1st	16 points	6th	5 points
2nd	15 points	7th	4 points
3rd	9 points	8th	3 points
4th	7 points	9th	2 points
5th	6 points	10th	1 point

Points ( 10 ) will be awarded to all competitors that are classified as a “Finisher”

“Finisher Points” are in addition to points for placing 1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup>.

A “Finisher” is a competitor that has completed 50% of the laps of the winner.

Drivers may count their best 6 events
