For 2011, Group 12 was established for Production-based contemporary cars, with their classification based on performance history. With a full season of competition and feedback from competitors, a change to this Group is warranted.

Group 12 cars will be merged into Groups 10 and 11, based on their performance history and what we have experienced in 2011. **Group 12 will no longer exist.** These cars will have separate Classes within Group 10 and 11 in order to retain the integrity of the current classes in each Group.

Extremely Important: These cars will now be subject to an eligibility requirement (date).

**All cars that were formerly part of SVRA Group 12 must have a production date from 1999 to 5 years from the current competition calendar year.** For 2012, cars newer than 2007 will not be accepted for regular Historic competition.

Cars newer than this requirement *may* be accepted on an invitational basis only and would not be eligible for a podium, trophies or points.

Group 12 Class A (5.1 Litre and above) to Group 11 Class MP1

Group 12 Class B (3.6 Litre to 5.0 Litre) to Group 11 Class MP2

Group 12 Class C (2.1 litre to 3.5 Litre) to Group 10 Class MP1

Group 12 Class D (Up to 2.0 Litre) to Group 10 Class MP2

Performance of these cars in their new Groups and Classes will be monitored and adjustments for safety and competition will take place at the discretion of SVRA officials.

Group 10 and Group 11 "Description and Class Lists" will reflect the above changes.
