SVRA participation in the Mobil 1—"12 Hours of Sebring" has been a long standing tradition for Vintage and Historic racers, Sebring International and especially the race fans. Participants have known that this is a Vintage event like no other with its own personality.

With input from SVRA staff, drivers, and Sebring International Raceway officials, some modifications to the event will take place for the 2013 event. Speed differentials on track and paddock & grid logistics have become an issue. These changes are being made to improve the true Vintage personality of the event and to insure the safety and enjoyment of its participants.

ENTRY

- Entry priority will be given to cars with Sebring 12 hour Vintage Heritage and to vehicles that are prepared to an "as originally raced" standard
- Entrants will be required to submit 2 current photos (3/4 front—3/4 rear) of the race car, an 2013 SVRA Race Car Compliance Form (RCCF) and an ECF form, if these forms are not already on record.
- (Open-wheel cars are NOT part of this event, per 12 Hour of Sebring history)
- Entries for this event will be limited and past participation and/or submission on an entry for the 2013 Mobil 1 "12 Hours of Sebring" does not constitute automatic acceptance of ANY entry for this years event.

ON TRACK

Track time has always been very limited at this event and will continue to be limited. For 2013, the race format will be as follows:

- There will be two, 1-Hour Enduro Races, one (1) on Thursday and one (1) on Friday.
- Sprint Race competitors are welcome and will be included within the Enduro Races by scoring the Sprint Race at the half-way point of each Enduro. Points will be tallied and awarded for the SVRA Sprint Series and the Keenan Motors Endurance Series.
- Race Groupings will be the Vintage/Classic Enduro and the Historic/GTP Enduro format, as other SVRA events. Groups will not be based on the old 1972 "manufacturer date separation" as previous 12 Hour of Sebring events.
- A Provisional Schedule will be posted once SVRA receives scheduling information from Sebring International Raceway.

PADDOCK

Instructions for paddock access and parking will be forwarded to entrants prior to the event. An entrant must be an actual "on-track participant" in order to park in the SVRA paddock area. Large, multi-car "Circus-type" tents <u>ARE NOT</u> permitted unless authorized by the SVRA Paddock Marshall. At this time, it is estimated that SVRA "load-in" will begin on Tuesday, March 12th at 8:00 am.
