

SVRA Spring Vintage Festival at Road America---Participant Information

Some basic information to make your SVRA event convenient and enjoyable at Road America.

Registration: located on your right after entering Gate 6. Registration hours will be as listed on the Event Schedule.

Load-In: will begin Wednesday at a time predicated by the track schedule of Road America. As of this writing, the approximate time of load-in will be no earlier than 4PM. Please follow the instructions by gate security staff as to staging areas for rigs. To ease congestion in the Paddock areas, participants will be loaded in 6 rigs/haulers at a time. Please be patient and work with the SVRA and track staff.

Late Arrivals: Road America does not allow load-in into any Paddock area after dark. Those arriving after dark will be asked to park in the staging areas.

Paddock Areas: if you have specific needs or requests regarding Paddock Space, please forward your Paddock Parking Information sheet that is part of your Entry Form to (or contact) Scott Marvicsin, SVRA Assistant Paddock Marshall (smarvicsin@yahoo.com).

The Shelby American Automobile Club Convention will occupy the entire North Paddock area (first paddock once you go through the tunnel). If you normally park in that area, please plan on an alternate area up in the Main Paddock areas.

FIRE LANES must be clear of all vehicles at all times. All rigs, motor homes, trailers etc., must be off premises after the conclusion of the event.

Fuel: race fuel is available at the pumps in the paddock. Pumps are Credit Card operated.

Nitrogen: if you have ordered nitrogen for the event from your supplier, normal drop-off is at the fuel station.

Garage Rentals: a limited number of garages are available at Road America. For availability and costs. please contact: Lori Bramstedt, lori@roadamerica.com or 1-800-365-7223.

Electric Service: available in limited areas at a fee of \$20 per plug. Hook-up tags are available at the "4 Mile Merchant" building in the Paddock area. Security staff will also be roaming to provide this service.

Pit Vehicles: of any type require a Road America permit sticker. These are \$25 dollars and available at the Road America window in the Registration Building. These permits are also good for all other 2013 vintage events at the track.

Motor Homes and Tents: that are being used for over-night accommodations (camping) require track permits. These are available at the Road America window in the Registration building and the Road America Offices.

Packages: packages that are shipped to the track for participants will have a handling fee of \$5.00 per package. There is a minimum charge of \$50 dollars for shipment unloading by R/A personnel.

RULES OF ROAD AMERICA

1.0 ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE ROAD AMERICA RACE TRACK WILL HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.1 A current -VALID spectator ticket.
 - 1.1.1 A ticket with stub(s) upon entering.
 - 1.1.2 A ticket AND A VALID "Pass-Out" upon re-entering.
- 1.2 A VALID credential (accompanied by a signed insurance-waiver witnessed by Road America/Club Staff personnel (PARTICIPANTS ONLY):
 - 1.2.1 Road America CREDENTIAL.
 - 1.2.2 Event sponsoring CLUB CREDENTIAL which is PROPERLY VALIDATED.
 - 1.2.3 Appropriate weekend WRISTBAND.

2.0 UNLICENSED VEHICLE GUIDELINES:

- 2.1 RACE VEHICLES being used in the race event are allowed on R/A property
- 2.2 AUTHORIZED ROAD AMERICA VEHICLES with a current year sticker are allowed on R/A property
- 2.3 Participants may use unlicensed light vehicles and equipment carts but must have a current event sticker or yearly permit for use of such vehicles on Road America property. These will be referred to as "pit vehicles".
 - 2.3.1 "Pit vehicle" registration (includes signing a liability waiver and acknowledgement of proper insurance) and fees must be taken care of at registration (locations may vary).
 - 2.3.2 Furthermore, according to the Wisconsin State Law, all ATVs should be registered by the State of Wisconsin, or by another State, in order to be operated within the State.
- 2.4 ROLLERBLADES, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SKATE BOARDS, AND ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on Road America property.
- 2.5 BICYCLES are permitted but may not be ridden in the COMPETITION PADDOCK AREA this is strictly PROHIBITED.

3.1 OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY:

- 3.2 Operators of all motor vehicles (including golf cars) must possess a valid state-issued driver's license.
- **3.2** At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

4.0 CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED BY COMPETITORS IN THE PADDOCK UNTIL AFTER ALL ON-TRACK ACTIVITES HAVE CONCLUDED FOR THE DAY.

5.0 RACE ENGINES MAY NOT BE RUN WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION:

- 5.1 Before 8:00 AM weekends/8:30 AM weekdays
- 5.2 After 6:00 PM weekends/5:00 PM weekdays
- 5.3 Car Clubs must vacate the property by 7:00 PM each day
- 5.4 On-Track Operations 8:00 6:00 Weekends, 8:30 5:00 Weekdays
- 5.5 When paddock space is in the Campground area, Campground quiet time of 10:00 pm applies. Generators can be used only from 7 am 10 pm and must not disturb other teams or campers.

6.0 ALL VEHICLES OR TENTS REMAINING OVERNIGHT ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST HAVE:

- 6.1 A valid Road America overnight camping permit PROPERLY DISPLAYED.
- 6.2 Overnight stays are not permitted without formal tent or motor home equipment.

7.0 NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION. PETS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY MUST EITHER BE:

- 7.1 Kept within the vehicle with adequate ventilation and fresh drinking water.
- 7.2 Kept under control of a leash.
- 7.3 All pets are the responsibility of the owner. If your pet disrupts or causes harm to another individual, it will be grounds for removal of you and your pet from the facility without refund.

8.0 FIRES, WHEN CONDITIONS PERMIT, MUST:

- 8.1 Be used for cooking only.
- 8.2 Be contained within a device designed for containing a fire.
- 8.3 Be completely extinguished before the coals, ashes, and remains are discarded.
- 8.4 Not be within 10 feet of spectator containment fence.
- 8.5 Not be within 100 feet of an occupied Road America concession stand.
- 8.6 Not be near other competitors' gasoline storage areas.

9.1 TRACK ETTIQUETTE/ACCESS:

- 9.2 At NO TIME are vehicles permitted to travel COUNTERCLOCKWISE on the track!
- 9.3 No one is allowed access to the track after operations hours for any reason, i.e. running, walking etc.

10.0 DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY:

- 10.1 Please do not drive stakes or poles into any asphalt surfaces.
- 10.2 Do not deface, cut, drive nails into or attach lines or any other objects to trees, bushes, light poles, site sign posts or buildings
- 10.3 Do not tamper with electrical facilities or any other facilities on RA property. Fines for destruction of property apply.
- 10.4 RA is not responsible for damage caused by other's actions.
- 10.5 Check voltage in electrical receptacles before using

11.0 ILLEGAL DRUGS, FIREWORKS, FIREARMS OR ANY TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE ARE NOT ALLOWED ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY!

12.0 VENDING is not allowed on Road America property without obtaining the proper permit. To obtain such permit, a vendor fee must be paid. This fee varies per event. Contact Road America for details and prices and to make arrangements.

Rules of Road America for Camping - Private Weekends

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Camping at Road America is meant to be a pleasant family experience; enjoying the attractions the outdoors has to offer. There is 24-hour security and patrols to insure that all campers will be able to enjoy the peace and quiet of the area. We ask that each of you help us to respect the rights of others. All motor homes and those tent camping must have the proper overnight pass properly displayed. Everyone entering Road America must have the proper event credentials. Overnight stays are not permitted without formal tent or self-contained RV equipment. All campers must vacate after the last checkered flag of the event. No guests - everyone must have proper WEEKEND or EVENT credentials.

MOTORHOME SPACES & CAMPSITES:

Tent or motor home camping is allowed only in the paddock, for participants only. Motor homes are \$55 and tents are \$40 for the duration of the event (Fees vary if event is a public event). Each campsite or motor home must have an adult. Sites must be kept clean and free from all debris. Glass bottles or containers are not permitted. We assume no responsibility for loss, theft or damage to personal property. A waste dump station is available in the West Paddock adjacent to the medical facility. Water is available on pit lane or in the Carousel where there is also another dump station. Electrical hook-ups are available in the trees motor home park or in the upper paddock area, which is an additional charge of \$20. This privilege can be purchased at the 4-Mile Merchant store in Competition Paddock. There are NO water hook-ups available.

QUIET TIME:

Please observe a quiet time between 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. daily. Children must not be left unattended and all campers should try to remain at their campsite after dark. Please remember, voices carry in the night. Use of profanity, loud music, obnoxious disturbances or nuisances will not be tolerated and will be asked to leave. No radios after 10:00 P.M. and absolutely no loud music at any time. Sounds made at your campsite should be heard only at your campsite during quiet time.

ENTRANCE GATE/REGISTRATION:

Participants should enter through Gate 6. Each club will determine a place for registration. Participants can purchase their tent camping or motor home permits at the RA Administrative Office during office hours (vary per event). Once participants have gone through the proper registration and have paid to stay on the property, they are allowed to enter/exit the facility anytime through Gate 6. If you are returning to the track after dark, please drive carefully and observe a 5 MPH speed limit. Be prepared to show proper credentials (wristband). For Road America Security or in an emergency call 920-892-2663.

MOTOR VEHICLES:

All operators of any motor vehicle on Road America property must posses a valid driver's license. Any vehicles driven after dark must have headlights. Unlicensed vehicles (ATV's, Scooters, private golf cars, etc.) can be used by competitors ONLY who must show proof of competition and register such vehicles at registration or the administrative office (fee does apply).

ROLLERBLADES, BICYCLES & SKATE BOARDS:

Rollerblades, Roller Skates and Skate Boards are not allowed anywhere on Road America property. Bicycle riding is permitted in the general spectator areas. Riding bicycles in the Competition Paddock area is prohibited with the exception of race competitors and team members.

PETS:

Pets are not allowed without Road America permission. Pets allowed must be kept under the control of a leash or kept in your vehicle with adequate ventilation and water. Pets are not permitted in Paddock areas during spectator events.

FIRES:

No open fires. Fires must be built in a device designed for elevating a fire off of the ground such as a grill or patio fire pits (available at any local sporting goods store).

Fires are permitted when weather conditions are normal (no high winds or dry conditions) and must be placed in a manner as not to endanger other people or property. Gasoline should not be used to light fires! Security officers, Road America staff and safety personnel reserve the right to instruct campers to extinguish any fires they feel are too big or that threaten other campers. Fires must be completely extinguished before discarding coals or ashes in containers clearly marked for that purpose. Violators of fire rules will pay a minimum fine of \$50 for each infraction.

DESTRUCTION:

Please **do not** drive stakes or poles into any asphalt surfaces. **Do not** deface, cut, drive nails into or attach lines or any other objects to trees, bushes, light poles, site sign posts or buildings. The State of Wisconsin has fines for those who destroy wild flowers, trees, or harm wildlife. There are more than 20 different species of wildlife located on over 628 acres of Road America's property. Enjoy what is around you - take only what you brought. No dishwashing allowed in restrooms.

DRUGS, EXPLOSIVES:

Non-prescription and illegal drugs are not permitted. Fireworks, firearms, potato launchers or any type of explosive are not allowed at Road America. Possession of such items will result in immediate removal from the property and further prosecution from local law enforcement.

Failure to observe the rules of this facility will result in instant cancellation of your camping privileges. You will be evicted without refund and parties involved will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. Road America reserves the right to refuse entrance at the gate.
