



U.S. Vintage Racing National Championship Awards

A. COTA Feature Races November 5th

1. First, second and third place in each race group receive gold, silver, or bronze medallion and a SVRA champion red hat at Victory Circle – location TBA
2. First second and third in each class, non-podium winners, receive a gold, silver or bronze medal. **Can be picked up at SVRA Information booth in the Media Center.**
3. **Please Note--Cars classified "NC" or carry a "double-classification" are not eligible for awards.**

B. Hawk Performance Endurance Races November 5th & 6th

1. First, second and third place overall will receive a gold, silver, and bronze medallion and a SVRA champion red hat at Victory Circle – location TBA
2. First place in each group will receive a gold medal and SVRA Champions red hat at Victory Circle – Location TBA
3. 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each group, will receive a gold, silver or bronze medal. **Can be picked up at SVRA information area in the Media Center.**
4. **Please Note--Cars classified "NC" or carry a "double-classification" are not eligible for awards.**

C. U. S. Vintage Racing National Championship Helmet Races November 6th

1. The special Bell Racing U.S. Vintage Racing National Championship helmets will be awarded as outlined in section D. In groups where there is a large field, large number of classes competing and/or very close competition, more than one helmet will be awarded. **Helmets located in media center, after being weighed at tech and winning position confirmed.**
2. First, second, and third place overall will receive gold, silver, and bronze medallions and a SVRA champions red hat at Victory Circle - location TBA.
3. **Please Note--Cars classified "NC" or carry a "double-classification" are not eligible for awards.**

Group 6	4	1 helmet for 6/AP winner 1 helmet for 6/BP winner 1 helmet for highest placed 6/TA & 6/AS finisher
Group 7	2	1 helmet for Group 7a winner (7/S2000) 1helmet for Group 7b winner (7/ASR, 7/BSR, & 7/M)
Group 8	2	1 helmet for highest placed 8/AP, BP, CP, or DP (Production) 1 helmet for Group 8 Sedans (RS, BS)
Group 9	2	1 helmet for highest placed 9/FA, 9/FA5, 9/FB or 9/FC car. 1 helmet for highest placed 9/F1 or 9/F2 car Note: 9/BOSS is currently not an SVRA East recognized Class
Group 10	2	1 helmet for highest placed 10/SC, Stock Car. 1 helmet for highest placed 10/GT or 10MP
Group 11	2	1 helmet for highest placed 11/GTP3 car. 1 helmet for the highest placed 11/GTP2 or 11/GTP1
Vintage/Classic Enduro	2	1 helmet for highest placed Vintage Category (Groups 1,2,3,4) 1 helmet for the Classic Category (Groups 5a, 6a, 8)
Historic GT/GTP Enduro	3	1 helmet for best finishing GTP- Classed car (SVRA 11/GTP3, GTP2, GTP1, or Group 9) car. Note: BOSS cars not eligible. 1 helmet for best finishing "Big Bore GT" car (SVRA 10/GT1 or 10SC) 1 helmet for best finishing "Small Bore" GT and Sports Racer (SVRA 5b, 6b, 7, 10/GT2, 10/GT3, 10/MP or Production category).

****Regular group helmet races must have a minimum of 6 cars in the class to be eligible for helmet**
