Licensing:

The National event is open to competitors that hold current competition licenses or driving privileges from VMC recognized vintage racing organization. If you hold a temporary license from a VMC recognized group, you may enter the event, but will be required to take the Driver Orientation Program (DOP) on Thursday. Make sure you have your Licenses, I.D. and any other documents that you need to submit with you when you go to Registration. If you forget or misplaced your documents, it is the participant's responsibility to contact their home organization for proper documentation if needed. This event is for all cars that hold true to the Gold Medallion preparation standards whether your car has been approved for the GM program or not.
