	Driver Meetings	Tech Shed - left side	
	Black Flag Station	Turn 6 and Start/Finish	
	Food	Concession stand in mid-paddock	
	Saturday night banquet	Concession stand in mid-paddock, Saturday night starting at 5:30

	Tires	Participants may order race tires for at track delivery mounting and balancing from Sasco Sports (434-822-7200 or dave@sascosport.com)	
	Fuel	Sunoco, the official racing fuel of SVRA is available on site with 93 and 98 octane unleaded and 110 leaded available. Credit card only.	
	Waste Handling	Three waste fluid stations with disposal containers for oil, antifreeze, brake fluid and fuel are available near the fuel stations	
	Nitrogen	Not available on-site	
	RV Info	OVER-NIGHT CAMPING IS ALLOWED in your hauler/tow vehicle in the PADDOCK.. If you have a separate RV, Bus or Toter that is not your Hauler/Tow vehicle, you are allowed to park in any paddock. RV Pad Rental with Hook-ups (3 spots with 30 or 50 amp service - \$25/day plus \$25/day for electric, 110v -\$10/day), are available through Roebling Road. 110 electrical hookups for non-campers is \$10/day. 	Camping	Tent camping permitted for \$10/day. Camp fires of any type are not permitted. Men's and Women's showers are located at Turn 5 and behind the concession stand.	
	EVENT RULES:	Load in Start time	It is planned that Initial Load-In will begin on Thursday, February 14th at 2:00pm and run until 6:00pm. Please proceed to Registration first for Credentials. Registration and load-in on Friday will be from 7am-5pm.
		Times engines can be run	Local ordinance prohibits the running of race engines between 8 PM and 8 AM and from 11 AM to 12 Noon on Sunday. (\$100 FINE for non-compliance.)
Sunday night stay?		Rigs and Haulers may stay overnight Sunday night, February 17 th in the Overflow Parking area outside the track.	
Animals		Allowed, but must be on a leash and owner is responsible for cleaning up after the animal	
Shorts in the pits		Yes	
Sound limits		Roebling Road requires sound levels to be under 104 db. The sound meter is located on driver's left just past the start/finish line. Two readings over this level will result in your car being flagged off the course. You will be allowed to fix the problem causing the car to be over the reading and re-enter.	
Fire Extinguishers		Georgia State Law requires each competitor to have a fire bottle displayed in their paddock area with a minimum rating of 10ABC.
