**Road America**

<b>LOCATIONS:</b>	<b>Staging</b>	Behind Registration - you should park, go to Registration and then get ready for load-in	
	<b>Registration</b>	At the entrance to the track at Gate 6 (off Hwy 57). Registration is on the right of the security check in as you enter the facility at Gate 6	
	<b>Tech</b>	In the paddock next to the garages and Scale Building near Pit Out	
	<b>Timing and Scoring</b>	2nd Floor of the Tower on Driver's Right next to Race Control	
	<b>Victory Circle</b>	Next to Tech near Pit Out	
	<b>Driver Meetings</b>	At the Road America Center - see schedule for meeting times	
	<b>Black Flag Station</b>	Turn 14 and Start/Finish - Note checkered flag will be displayed at 14 and S/F for all test day and practice sessions. Checkered only at S/F for qualifying and races. Also, the track has several mechanical black flag locations. If you see a mechanical black flag outside of Turn 14 and S/F, please pull off safely at the nearest corner.	
	<b>Food</b>	Gear Box near Turn 15 and St. John's near the tunnel	
	<b>Saturday night banquet</b>	Held at the Osthoff in Elkhart Lake - Tickets available in Registration for \$20 each	
	<b>TRACK SERVICES:</b>	<b>Shipments</b>	Can be sent to: Road America N7390 State Hwy 67 Plymouth, WI 53073 - be sure to include team/name and at-track telephone number
<b>Tires</b>		Participants may order race tires for at track delivery mounting and balancing from Sasco Sports ( 434-822-7200 or	
<b>Golf Carts</b>		Personal carts must have a Road America sticker which can be obtained at the Road America Administration Office. Operators must have a valid state-issued driver's license, Golf Cart rentals are available from Jim's Golf Cart Company which can be rented at the Road America Administration Building	
<b>Fuel</b>		Sunoco, the official racing fuel of SVRA will be available at the Sunoco pumps in mid paddock. 98 Octane, GTX unleaded and 110 leaded will be available at the event. We appreciate your patronage of this sponsor	
<b>Waste Handling</b>		Waste fluid "Safety Clean" containers are located throughout the paddock and near Tech	
<b>RV Info</b>		OVER-NIGHT CAMPING IS ALLOWED in your hauler/tow vehicle in the Paddock. space permitting and at the direction of the paddock Limited spots with electrical are available in the paddock and can be reserved in advance through Road America (800-356-7223) or at the Administration Building when you arrive. The cost will be \$50 for RVs and \$20 for electricity. The track also has Tiny Cabins available for weekend rentals on Driver's left just past the tower. These are rented through the Admin Building as well.	
<b>EVENT RULES:</b>		<b>Load in Start time</b>	It is planned that Initial Load-In will begin on Wednesday at approximately 5:00PM for Lane 1 (prep shops, 5th wheel rigs and vendors) and approximately 6:00PM for Lane 2 (all pull along tag trailers sent in to the paddock)
		<b>Times engines can be run</b>	No running of race engines between 10 PM and 7 AM
		<b>Sunday night stay?</b>	Rigs and Haulers may stay overnight Sunday night, May 19th in the Overflow Parking area behind Registration. Rigs will need to move to this location if staying overnight
		<b>Animals</b>	Allowed, but must be on a leash and owner is responsible for cleaning up after the animal
	<b>Shorts in the pits</b>	Yes, except for during the Enduro Races	
	<b>Sound limits</b>	Not applicable during this event	
	<b>Fire Extinguishers</b>	Each competitor must have a fire bottle displayed in their paddock area with a minimum rating of 10ABC.	
	<b>Head &amp; Neck Restraints</b>	Required	
	<b>Transponders</b>	Required, limited number available for rental at Tech	
	<b>Drones</b>	Drones are not allowed at any time at Road America
