**Package pickup**

Just inside the main paddock entrance. On the right – Hours of operation 8:00AM-5:00PM (831-242-8231)

**Staging**

South Boundary Road Gate starting on Wednesday, April 29, 2020. South Boundary Road is located off General Jim Moore Blvd., near the intersection of Canyon Del Rey (Hwy 218) and General Jim Moore Blvd.

**Load in**

It is planned that Initial Load-In will begin on Wednesday at **9:00AM for Lane 1** (prep shops, 5th wheel rigs and vendors).  
Wednesday at approximately **11:00M for Lane 2** (all pull along tag trailers sent in to the paddock)

**Note, that Trans Am staffs up for different load in hours than SVRA, so their rigs may be entering the paddock at different times than SVRA participants.**

**Registration**

Trailer on the right side of the road at the South Boundary Road Gate.

**Tech**

On the right at the entrance to the main paddock and Garage 20.

**Fuel**

Sunoco will be available in the main paddock between turns 10 and 11. Sunoco 260 GTX 98 Unleaded, Sunoco Standard 110 and Sunoco Supreme 112 will be available. No pre-orders necessary.

### **Waste Fuel**

Waste fluid "Safety Clean" containers are located near the track fuel pumps in the paddock

### **Tires**

Participants may order race tires for at track delivery mounting and balancing from Roger Krause (510-582-5031) or Tim Gerhardt at Hoosier Tire West (tgerhardt@hoosiertirewest or 559-485-4612) You may also order tires through Tire Rack (contact info pending) - you will need to have the tires purchased from Tire Rack shipped to you so you can bring them to the track and have Roger Krause or Hoosier Tire West mount them.

### **Garages**

19 garages are available for rental at \$750 per garage for the weekend. Each garage can hold 2 vehicles.

### **RV/Camping**

OVER-NIGHT CAMPING IS ALLOWED in your hauler/tow vehicle in the PADDOCK, space permitting and at the direction of the paddock marshalls. RV Spots are available near the paddock through WeatherTech Laguna Seca.

### **Timing and Scoring**

Located across the track from Race Control. A small number of transponders are available for rent if you notify Janet Harhay tickets ([jharhay@aol.com](mailto:jharhay@aol.com)) by April 24<sup>th</sup>.

### **Golf Cart Rentals**

Ordered through GTI (link pending on website). Please order early to ensure supply is available at the track. Note: all personal golf carts will need to have a golf cart sticker (\$50) and provide proof of insurance (form will be posted shortly) which can be obtained from the Administration office next to the fuel pumps. Please plan ahead. If needed, insurance with the necessary coverage can be obtained from SVRA.

### **Engines Running**

No running of race engines after 6PM and before 7:30AM.

### **Shorts in the Pits**

Long pants, closed shoes and covered shoulders are required in the hot and cold pits by this venue, except for the time during the Trans Am Fan Walks.

### **Sound Control**

Not in effect for this event

### **Helmets**

If you leave the paddock on a scooter or motorcycle, California law requires that you wear a helmet. The roads at WTLS outside the main paddock are public roads

### **Pets**

Not allowed except for Guide Dogs and they must always be on a leash, and owners must pick up after them.

### **Concessions**

Cruisin' Café in the paddock will be open starting Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup> at 8:00am.
