4.08 Miles, 15 Turns

Road America asks that social distancing be followed for this event. Temperatures will be taken when entering the facility. Be prepared for that and allow extra time when you come to the facility.

**Staging**

Behind Registration. Please stage behind the flag for your group (Red Flag for prep shops, 5<sup>th</sup> wheel rigs and vendors, Blue Flag for pull along tag trailers). Please park, go to Registration and then prepare for load-in.

**Load in**

It is planned that Initial Load-In will begin on Thursday at **7:00AM**. Priority will be given to test day participants

**Registration**

Entrance to the track at Gate 6 just off HWY 67. Registration Building is to the right of the security check-in point.

**Tech**

In the paddock next to the garages and scale building as you exit the track at Pit Out

### **Fuel**

Sunoco, the official racing fuel of SVRA will be available at the Sunoco pumps in mid paddock. 98 Octane, GTX unleaded and 110 leaded will be available at the event. We appreciate your patronage of this sponsor.

### **Waste Fuel**

Waste fluid "Safety Clean" containers are located throughout the paddock and near tech.

### **Tires**

Participants may order race tires for at track delivery mounting and balancing from Sasco Sports ( 434-822-7200 or dave@sascosports.com).

### **Garages**

Limited garages are available for rental through Road America (800-356-7223).

### **RV/Camping**

OVER-NIGHT CAMPING IS ALLOWED in your hauler/tow vehicle in the PADDOCK, space permitting and at the direction of the paddock marshalls. Limited spots with electrical are available in the paddock and can be reserved in advance through Road America (800-365-7223), roadamerica.com or at the Administration Building when you arrive. The cost will be \$50 for RVs and \$20 for electricity. The track also has Tiny Cabins available for weekend rentals on Driver's left just past the tower. These are rented through the Admin Building as well.

### **Timing and Scoring**

Tower to the right of Race Control A small number of transponders are available for rent if you notify Janet Harhay ([jharhay@aol.com](mailto:jharhay@aol.com)) by June 12th.

### **Driver's Meetings**

Will be done via conference call. Details will be sent prior to the event.

### **Black Flag locations**

Turn 14 and Start/Finish - Note checkered flag will be displayed at 14 and S/F for all test day and practice sessions. Checkered only at S/F for qualifying and races. Also, the track has several mechanical black flag locations. If you see a mechanical black flag outside of Turn 14 and S/F, please pull off safely at the nearest corner.

### **Victory Circle**

Road America Victory Lane in the paddock across the track from Start/Finish

### **Golf Cart Rentals**

Personal carts must have a Road America sticker which can be obtained at the Road America Administration Office. Operators must have a valid state-issued driver's license, Golf Cart rentals are available on Road America's website at roadamerica.com.

### **Engines Running**

No running of race engines after 10PM and before 7AM.

### **Shorts in the Pits**

Yes, except during the Enduro races.

### **Sound Control**

Not in effect for this event

### **Drones**

Drones are not allowed at any time at Road America.

### **Fire Extinguishers**

Each competitor must have a fire bottle displayed in their paddock area with a minimum rating of 10ABC.

### **Head and Neck Restraints**

Required

### **Pets**

Pets are allowed, but they must always be on a leash, and owners must pick up after them.

### **Concessions**

Gear Box and St. John's in the paddock

### **Load Out**

Rigs and Haulers may stay overnight Sunday night, June 21st in the Overflow Parking area behind Registration. Rigs will need to move to this location if staying over Sunday night.
