Staging

Turn into the track at Gate one, SVRA rigs turn left into the staging lanes and follow the signs.

Walk back to registration in the far lot to register.

Load in

It is planned that initial Load-In will begin on Wednesday at approximately 1:00PM for Lane 1 (prep shops, 5th wheel rigs and vendors), approximately 2:00PM for Lane 2 (all pull along tag trailers sent in to the paddock)

Note, that Trans Am staffs up for different load in hours than SVRA, so their rigs may be entering the paddock at different times than SVRA participants.

Registration

Right side of the road as you enter Gate 1. Note: you will need to turn in a COVID release form when you register. The form will be sent with the notice on the Driver Meeting and paper copies will also be available at Registration.

Tech

In the Tower Paddock near the skid pads by Pit out.

Fuel

Sunoco, the official racing fuel of SVRA will be available at the Sunoco pumper near the track fuel

pumps. The Sunoco contact is David Wells (david@insingerperformance.com). Sunoco will have 110 and Supreme 112 leaded, 98 unleaded (260 GTX) without ethanol and 100 with ethanol.

Fueling Hours: Thurs., Fri., Sat. -7:30am. - 4pm. Sun. – 7:30am. - 11am.

Waste Fuel

Waste fluid "Safety Clean" containers are located near the track VP fuel pumps in the Tower Paddock

Tires

Participants may order race tires for at track delivery mounting and balancing from Sasco Sports (434-822-7200 or dave@sascosports.com) You may also order tires through Tire Rack - you will need to have the tires purchased from Tire Rack shipped to you so you can bring them to the track. SASCO will mount and balance them for you for a fee, but do not have these tires shipped to SASCO.

Garages

No garages are available for rental at this venue.

RV/Camping

OVER-NIGHT CAMPING IS ALLOWED in your hauler/tow vehicle in the PADDOCK, space permitting and at the direction of the paddock marshals. Limited electrical is available in the paddock, payable to Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta. No water or dump station on site, but servicing can be obtained from Clay Crocker with Nix Tank Company (clay@nixtankco.com or 678-776-6340).

New Tower, on the 4th floor. A small number of transponders are available for rent in T&S if you notify Janet Harhay (jharhay@aol.com) by Nov 13th.

Driver's Meetings

Planned to be done via virtual meeting prior to event.

Quiet Hours

Sunday 10:00AM-12:00PM is a quiet time at Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta. No on-track race activities or running of engines in the paddock are allowed during this time. The PA will be used only for emergency messages.

No running of race engines after 8PM and before 8AM.

Shorts in the Pits

Not allowed in the hot pits over the wall. Are allowed in the cold pits, except during Enduro races.

Sound Control

Not in effect for this event

Pets

Pets are allowed, but they must always be on a leash, and owners must pick up after them.

Concessions

Paddock Grill in the Tower Paddock – hours to be posted at the Paddock Grill.

Load Out

Rigs and Haulers may stay overnight Sunday night, November 22nd in the Overflow Parking area outside the track in the staging area near Registration - Paddock must be vacated Sunday night.
