



## 2021 Trans Am Speedfest WeatherTech Laguna Seca (WTLS), (April 29 – May 2, 2021) Supplemental Event Information

### COVID

**Masks will be required by all participants and spectators while on the property** - Social distancing should be practiced. Temperatures may be taken at the main gate each time you enter. Your temperature must be at or below 100.4 to be allowed to enter. **COVID Compliance is Mandatory. Your credential will be removed for non-compliance and you could be subject to additional penalties.**

### Package pickup

Right side as you enter the main paddock. Open 8:00-5:00 Monday-Saturday (831-242-8321)

### Transporters Entering CA

**California Vehicle Code 35401.5, affects solely motorsports industry transporters. Permit needed**

It states that "... a combination of vehicles consisting solely of a truck tractor semitrailer combination with a kingpin to the rearmost axle measurement limit of not more than 46 feet, a trailer length of not more than 56 feet, and used exclusively or primarily in connection with motorsports..." will need a permit when traveling in the state of California. Permit instructions posted separately at [gotransam.com](http://gotransam.com) in the Competitor Section under the Laguna Event Information.

### Staging

Teams coming from Sonoma, may park in the Lakebed area from Monday to load-in. WTLS will be charging \$25 per day for parking your vehicle or \$50 per day if you plan on staying in your rig and/or working on your car before load-in. Additional information can be found in the Laguna Parking Document. The forms to reserve your spot are posted on the Laguna event section at [svra.com](http://svra.com)

### **Load-In**

Enter the track from South Boundary road only. Continue past Barloy Canyon road and follow the perimeter road. Depending on your arrival time, (before 9:00 AM) you will be directed to the lakebed area. Turn into the paved lot and get in line there. Pull forward and stop. If you arrive after 9:00 AM, we will begin moving the staged teams, and the newer arrivals out onto the perimeter road. You will proceed around to the Main paddock entrance where you will need to sign a track waiver, and receive a LOAD IN ONLY paper wristband. You will also get your temperature checked at this point. You will then be escorted to your Paddock location.

### **Registration**

Once parked proceed to the small garage building numbered 21-24 next to the big garage. Registration will be there and ready to process you. Your LOAD IN BAND will not authorize your return to the track on Thursday. You must register Wednesday with SVRA to return, for the weekend.

### **Paddock power**

Power will be limited, so please plan for the potential of not having power

### **Garages**

### **Driver Meeting**

The SVRA Driver's Meeting will be virtual and sent to your email address on file with the SVRA. It will also run all day Thursday and Friday at the SVRA Administration trailer in the paddock, for your review, in case you missed it on line. You may also view it on our Facebook and YouTube pages.

Room in the trailer across from the Triple Tower.

### **Timing and Scoring**

Across the track from the Race Control Tower - Driver's right

### **Black Flag**

Turn 7 and Start/Finish

### **Fuel**

Sunoco, the official racing fuel of SVRA, and will be available in the main paddock between turns 10 and 11. Sunoco 260 GTX 98 Unleaded and Sunoco Supreme 112 will be available. If you leave the paddock on a scooter or motorcycle, California law requires that you wear a helmet. The roads at WTLS outside the main paddock are public roads
