COVID

Masks will be required by all participants and spectators while on the property - Social distancing should be practiced. A COVID release will need to be signed at the main gate, before entering. Your temperatures may be taken at the main gate each time you enter. Your temperature must be at or below 100.4 to be allowed to enter. **COVID Compliance is Mandatory. Your credential will be removed for non-compliance and you could be subject to additional penalties.**

Registration

Located immediately to your right as you enter the track property.

Sound

This event is sound exempt

Staging/Load-in

Staging of trailers prior to initial load-in will require driving past registration, up the hill to Lot 2. Wait till about 1:00 when rigs will begin to move. You will be directed to proceed down the hill into the paddock, where a Marshall will escort you to your designated spot.

Garages

Garages are available for \$250 for a half garage and \$500 for a full garage and can be reserved through kathy@svra.com, subject to availability. A full garage is 20 x 35 feet. Only a few remain open to rent.

Personal cars

There will be no parking of personal cars in the paddock due to space constraints. You will need to park your car at the top of the hill and walk down to your paddock location.

Tech

Tech will be a roving style, where an Inspector will come to your paddock. Just put your helmet on the roof or front cowling of your car signifying you are ready. They will come find you. You do not need to be inspected to run Thursday on test day, but you must get your car teched sometime Thursday, to get on track Friday. The tech office will be in the Media center.

Grid

Next to pit lane. Enter the grid area via the road between the Media Center and the Grandstand.

Race Control and Timing and Scoring

Located on the 4th floor of the Tower in the middle of the grandstands next to the paddock

Black Flag

Turns 5,9 and Start/Finish

Victory Circle

Next to the entrance to the grid/pit lane

Sunoco Fuel

Sunoco Supreme 112 leaded is available 24/7 at the Sunoco gas station at the track.

Sunoco 260 GTX fuel services will be provided by Sunoco Distributor "Motorsports Racing Products" who will have Sunoco 260 GTX available in drums and by the gallon. They will be located at the Sunoco gas station at the track.

Fluid Waste Disposal

Safety Kleen containers are located next to the Medical Center by the concession stand.

Concession Stand

Will be open Thurs-Sun from 8:00AM – 2:00PM.

Load Out

Rigs and Haulers may stay overnight Sunday night 4/25, but you will need to move the rigs to Lot 2. You may work on cars in this area (not paved) until Tuesday night 4/27 (no additional charge). Teams going to WeatherTech Laguna Seca may go directly to Laguna and park in the Lakebed area (detailed instructions will be shown on the Laguna load in map) Prior vehicle parking application must be completed. Please see the application on the Laguna load in document, on the SVRA.com site.

Pets

Pets are allowed in the paddock, provided they are on a leash and are properly picked up after. No pets are allowed in the Pit Lane
