COVID-19 EVENT INFORMATION

In light of the current pandemic situation, please be aware that Parella Motorsports Holdings, SVRA, Trans Am Series, and Sebring International Raceway are not liable for any potential transmission of illnesses.

- Individuals with a confirmed infection or with a known exposure to an infected person within five days may not access the SpeedTour event. It is recommended that you obtain a negative test before attending events.
- State and local health department mandates regarding COVID-19 protocols will be adhered to during all SpeedTour events.
- Meetings or gatherings of large numbers of people in enclosed spaces are discouraged.
- Masks are required to be worn at registration, indoors, and whenever social distancing of 6 or more feet is not possible during long periods of time.
- If you experience symptoms during the event, you are encouraged to test and seek necessary medical assistance.

Length of Circuit/Turns: 3.74 miles/17-turn road course

Race Direction: Clockwise

Pole Position: Drivers Left

Start & Finish Line: Pit Straight

Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

Registration: All participants must go to registration at the Sebring Main Office, located to the right of the Main Gate, before entering the facility.

Grid Location: SVRA: Inside T17
Trans Am: Inside T15/16 for Practice and Qualifying; Inside T17 for Races

Track Entrance: For those wishing to enter the track once a session has begun, please proceed to the southern pit lane gate near T17.

Race Control Location: Fourth floor of the Race Control Tower/Pit Building

Timing & Scoring: Second floor of the Race Control Tower/Pit Building

Stewards' Office: SVRA: Race Control
Trans Am: Series Trailer

Meeting Locations: SVRA Test Day & Drivers' Meeting: Series Trailer
SVRA Driver/Track Orientation: Media A & B, first floor of the Tower
Trans Am Meetings: Operations Building, near Gate 4 & the Skid Pad

- Camping:** Water hookups are limited. No dump station on property. Tent camping permitted. Campfires of any type are not permitted. Men's and Women's showers are located throughout the paddock. No overnight camping in area outside Registration.

PADDOCK INFORMATION

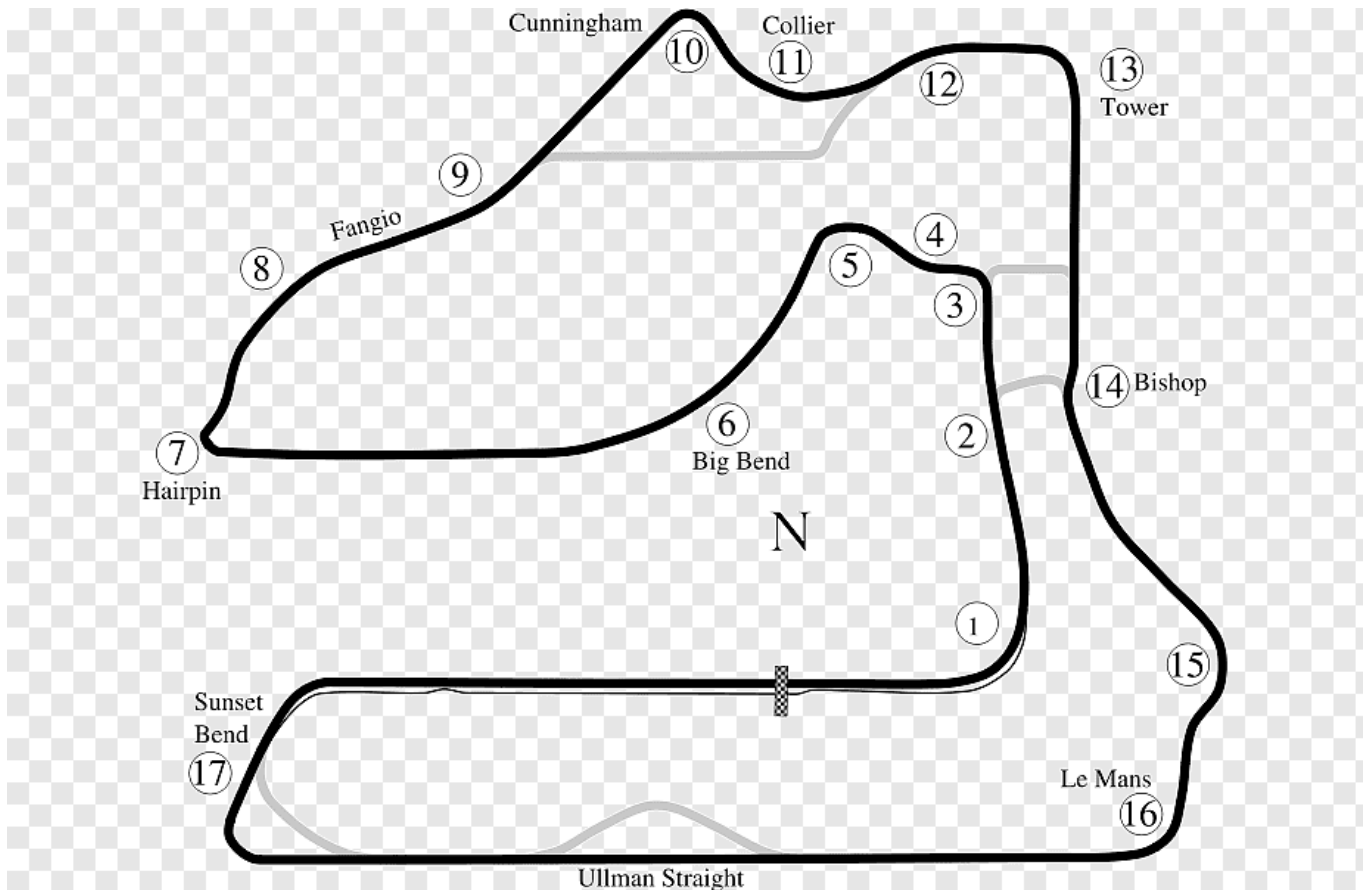
- Staging:** **SVRA:** Enter through Gate 4 on Carroll Shelby Road and stage in the skid pad lot. Do NOT arrive before Wednesday morning. This staging location will close on Thursday, February 24 at 1:00 pm and all late arrivals must go to registration and enter through the Main Gate.
Trans Am: Enter through Gate 4 on Carroll Shelby Road and stage beyond the skid pad in the grass between Carroll Shelby Road and the backstraight fence. Look for signage. Do NOT arrive before Wednesday. This staging location will close on Thursday, February 24 at 1:00 pm and all late arrivals must go to registration and enter through the Main Gate.
- Staging Hours:** **SVRA:** Begin Wednesday, February 23 at 6:00 am
Trans Am: Begin Wednesday, February 23 at 12:00 pm
- Load In:** **SVRA:** Wednesday, February 23 at 1:00 pm
Trans Am: Wednesday, February 23 at 3:00 pm
- Load Out:** Sunday, February 27 at 10:00 pm. Trucks can be parked on Midway Drive (across the bridge) until Monday morning, but all vehicles must clear the paddock Sunday night.
- Concrete Blocks:** Concrete blocks to anchor your canopies are available from the track. The fee is \$40 per block, delivered. Contact Matt Muha in advance at mmuha@sebringraceway.com
- Quiet Hours:** No race engines can be run between the hours of 8:00 pm and 7:00 am
- Cleanliness:** It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.
- Paddock Power:** RV spaces are being rented at the paddock power stations. RVs will have power hookup priority. If space or power is available, participants can use it.
- Personal Vehicles:** No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you used it to tow your trailer. All street cars must be parked in designated "STREET CAR PARKING" areas. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.
- RVs:** RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer. RV spots will be available for purchase via your registrar.

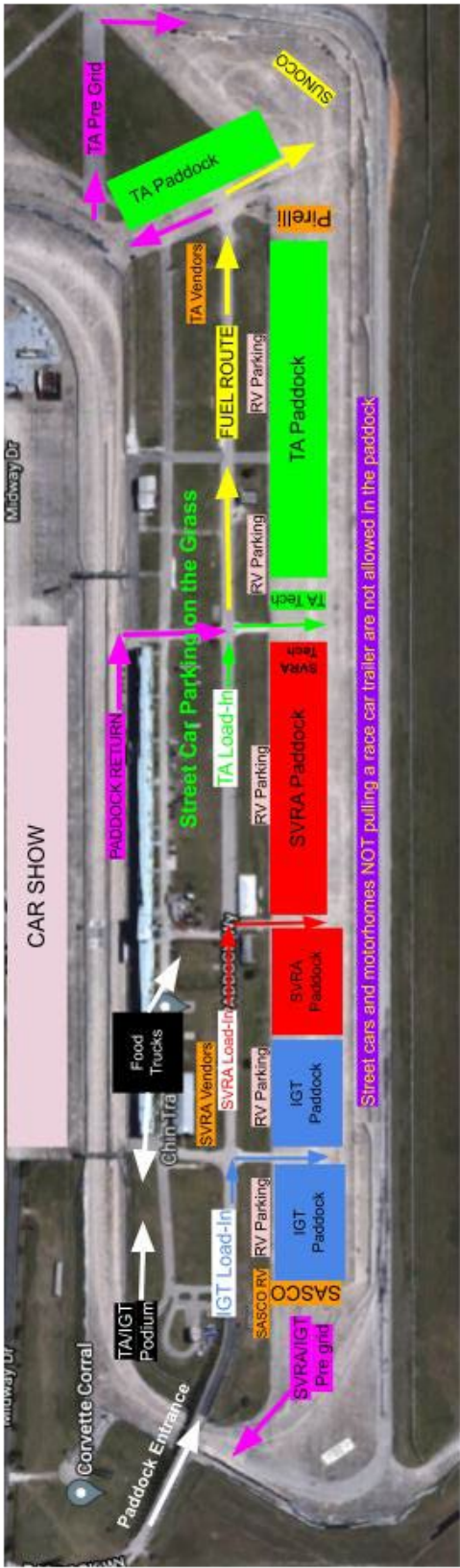
