- State and local health department mandates regarding COVID-19 protocols will be adhered to during all SpeedTour events.
- Meetings or gatherings of large numbers of people in enclosed spaces are discouraged.
- Masks are required to be worn at registration, indoors, and whenever social distancing of 6 or more feet is not possible during long periods of time.

**Race Direction:** Counter-clockwise

**Pole Position:** Drivers Left

**Corner Signaling:** Mix of marshal-manned stations and light panels

**Start & Finish Line:** Front Straight of Oval

**Pit Lane Speed:** 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

**Registration:** All participants must go to registration at the Main Entrance; see map

**Grid Location:** South side of Xfinity Garages

**Race Control Location:** Suite Level of the Tower

**Timing & Scoring:** Suite Level of the Tower

**Stewards' Office:** SVRA: Series Trailer  
Trans Am: Series Trailer

**Meeting Locations:** Media Center, look for signs

**Podium Ceremony:** Victory Circle is in front of the Media Center, between the two garage buildings

**Black Flag Locations:** Turns 8 and Start/Finish

**Scooters/Bikes:** Stick scooters, hoverboards, single-wheeled powered vehicles and anything else without a seat are not allowed. Violators will be asked to leave the facility. No warnings will be given.

**Camping:** RV hookups are available on the north side of the Paddock Club and slots can be reserved through [kathy@svra.com](mailto:kathy@svra.com). Additional spaces are available outside the track at [Camping World Racing Resort](http://CampingWorldRacingResort.com).

**Waste Disposal:** Disposal containers for oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and fuel are available in the Xfinity Garages near Victory Circle. Look for the Safety Kleen signs.

**Pets:** Pets are discouraged but allowed in the paddock and must be always kept on a leash. No pets allowed on grid or pit lane. Owners must clean up after pets.

<b>Staging:</b>	Fan Zone at the corner of Concord Pkwy South and Morehead Rd. See the map for more details.
<b>Staging Begins:</b>	<u>SVRA</u> : Wednesday, March 16 at 9:00 am; do not arrive earlier. <u>Trans Am</u> : Wednesday, March 16 at 1:00 pm; do not arrive earlier.
<b>Load-In Begins:</b>	<u>SVRA</u> : Wednesday, March 16 at 3:00 pm <u>Trans Am</u> : Wednesday, March 16 at 4:00 pm
<b>Load Out:</b>	Sunday, March 20 at 8:00 pm. Trucks can be parked in Fan Zone (staging area) until Monday morning, but all vehicles must clear the paddock Sunday night.
<b>Garages:</b>	Garages are free to the first 50 entries for SVRA and Trans Am respectively. You will be allowed to park adjacent to your garage space, but no awnings will be allowed. Additional paddock spaces will be available but overall space is very limited.
<b>Quiet Hours:</b>	No race engines can be run between the hours of 8:00 pm and 7:00 am
<b>Cleanliness:</b>	It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.
<b>Personal Vehicles:</b>	No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you used it to tow your trailer. All street cars must be parked in designated "STREET CAR PARKING" areas. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.
<b>RVs:</b>	RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer and will not be allowed to disconnect. RV spots will be available for purchase; see Camping in Circuit Details.
<b>Paddock Movements:</b>	There will be additional traffic in the paddock with the Optima Search for the Ultimate Street Car joining us at this event. Please be mindful of track security and event staff directing traffic to ensure we have a safe event.
