Race Direction: Clockwise

Pole Position: Drivers Left

Start & Finish Line: Pit Straight

Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

Registration: Located in Guest Services Building to the left of the main entry gate.

Grid Location: Next to pit lane. Enter the grid area via the road between the Media Center and the Grandstand.

Track Entrance: For those wishing to enter the track once a session has begun, please proceed to grid and wait for Grid Marshall to release you.

Race Control Location: Located on the 4th floor of the Tower in the middle of the main grandstands.

Timing & Scoring: Located on the 4th floor of the Tower in the middle of the main grandstands.

Staging Location: Enter Facility via main entrance. Please do not arrive prior to 2pm on Tuesday April 26th. If arriving before registration opens sign track waiver at main security shack and proceed to Lot 2 for staging. During registration hours you may stage to register in front of guest services please see the diagram then proceed to Lot 2.

Please do not arrive before the times listed above.

Load In Begins: Wednesday, April 27

5:00pm-7:00pm Garages & A paddock (HTA & B-Sedans)

Load Out: Sunday, May 1 at 8 pm. All vehicles must clear the paddock. You may stay overnight Sunday in Lot 2,

Cleanliness: It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.

Paddock Power: There is no power in the paddock please plan accordingly.
Personal Vehicles: No personal cars will be allowed in the paddock during the event, beginning with load-in. Shuttles will be running from Lot 2.

Tow Vehicles Tow vehicles will be allowed in the paddock on Wednesday and Thursday while competitors are loading in only. Temporary delivery passes will be available from registration for the rest of the weekend.
