Length of Circuit/Turns: 2.47miles/16-turn road course
Race Direction: Counter-Clockwise
Pole Position: Drivers left
Start & Finish Line: Pit Straight
Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.
Registration: All participants must go to registration, located in the small ticket booth at the Main Gate.
Grid Location: Cold pits, located behind garages, use pit lane entrance by garages.
Track Entrance: Use pit lane entrance by garages.
Race Control Location: 1st Floor of the building near start/ finish, middle of the building.
Timing & Scoring: 1st Floor of the building near start/ finish, East End of the building
Stewards' Office: SVRA: Race Control
Trans Am: Garage 1
Meeting Locations: SVRA: Performance Center
Trans Am: Performance Center
Podium Ceremony: Located outside the Performance Center (big red building in the paddock)
Black Flag Locations: Turn 12, Start/Finish
Track Security: Overnight stationed out of main entrance booth.
Scooters/Bikes: Helmets required, must drive slow in paddock area
Hot/Cold Pit Dress Code: Long pants, close toed shoes, shoulders covered.
