Length of Circuit/Turns: 2.2 miles/11-turn road course

Race Direction: Counterclockwise

Pole Position: Drivers Left

Start & Finish Line: Pit Straight

Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

Registration: **Wednesday: Lakebed Thursday/Friday/Saturday/Sunday: South Boundary Rd.**
All participants must go to registration before entering the paddock.

Grid Location: In paddock, between turns 10 and 11.

Track Entrance: For those wishing to enter the track once a session has begun, please proceed to "Center gate" turn right and enter cold pits, U-Turn onto hot pit lane proceed with caution.

Race Control Location: Room in the trailer across from the Triple Tower.

Timing & Scoring: Across the track from the Race Control Tower - Driver's right

Stewards' Office: SVRA: Race Control
Trans Am: Series Trailer

Meeting Locations: SVRA: Newman Building across from the souvenir store
Trans Am: Newman Building across from the souvenir store

Podium Ceremony: Victory Circle is located near "Center gate" track entry.

Black Flag Locations: Turns 7 and Start/Finish

Track Security: Operations Office

Scooters/Bikes: If you leave the paddock on a scooter or motorcycle, California law requires that you wear a helmet; outside the main paddock are public roads.

Hot/Cold Pit Dress Code: Long pants, closed-toed shoes, shoulders covered.

Staging Location:	Enter Facility Enter via South Boundary Rd. off Hwy 218 & Gen. Jim Moore. If you plan to stay in the Lakebed between the back-to-back events, please see the Vehicle Storage Form (\$25 per vehicle per night): Lakebed Vehicle Storage Form
Staging Hours:	SVRA & Trans Am earliest arrival from Sonoma evening of Sunday April 30 th SVRA: Tuesday, May 3rd 9:00 am-5:00 pm Lakebed; Thursday, May 4th before 7 am on South Boundary Trans Am: Earliest arrival is Wednesday May 3rd at 9:00 am if not coming directly from Sonoma.
Load In Begins:	SVRA: Wednesday, May 3rd 9:00 am-5:00 pm Trans Am: Wednesday, May 3 rd at 9:30AM (for those renting a garage), 1:00pm – 3:00pm for those doing the Optional Test Day on Thursday Thursday May 4 th from 8:15 am to 11 am
Load Out:	Monday, May 8th at 9 am All vehicles must clear the paddock.
Water Barrels:	Water barrels are available from WeatherTech Raceway for your canopies. Contact Hayle Leontieff LeontieffH@laguna-seca.com
Quiet Hours:	No race engines between 6:00 pm and 7:30 am. Facility quiet hours between 10 pm and 7 am.
Cleanliness:	It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.
Paddock Power:	There is no power in the paddock. Please plan accordingly.
Personal Vehicles:	No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock. All street cars must be parked in Blue 2 Lot (just outside the paddock entry) There will be shuttles running from Blue Lot 2 and the Paddock. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the paddock, must be approved for parking pass, please use caution, and observe all fire lanes.
RVs:	RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer and fit within the allocated space.
