Scooters/Bikes: Motorcycle and Moped Helmet Law Chapter 814.269 Must wear a motorcycle helmet that is DOT-

compliant. The only exception is 814.290 when operating a vehicle designed to travel with three wheels in

contact with the ground at speeds of less than 15 mph.

Hot/Cold Pit Dress Code: Long pants, close toed shoes, shoulders covered.

**Camping:** Permitted, power is limited availability not guaranteed. No dump station on property. Tent camping

permitted. Fires must be contained in a portable and self-contained unit that is propane and designed to be a fire pit off the ground with a flame height less than 4-inches. NO WOOD campfires are allowed.

Waste Disposal: Use of the Safety-Kleen waste drums is mandatory for used oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting

material. Located throughout the paddock. Please do not place any flammables in trash cans or

dumpsters.
