Length of Circuit/Turns: 1.97 miles/12-turn road course

Race Direction: Clockwise

Pole Position: Driver's right

Start & Finish Line: Pit Straight

Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

Registration: Thursday - located in the paddock, outside of the Rose Cup Room.
Friday - Sunday located in the parking lot to the right of the main entrance.

Grid Location: South Paddock, see map.

Track Entrance: For those wishing to enter the track once a session has begun, please proceed to the grid.

Race Control Location: Rose Cup Room 3rd Floor

Timing & Scoring: North Paddock Tower

Stewards' Office: SVRA: Rose Cup Room
Trans Am: Trans Am Tech tent.

Meeting Locations: SVRA: Grandstands next to Rose Cup Room
Trans Am: Grandstands next to Rose Cup Room

Podium Ceremony: Victory Circle is located right outside Rose Cup Room

Black Flag Locations: Turns 8 and 12

Track Security: Overnight security will be at the main entrance as well as a roving the paddock. Please ensure that your belongings are secured overnight.

Scooters/Bikes: Motorcycle and Moped Helmet Law Chapter 814.269 Must wear a motorcycle helmet that is DOT-compliant. The only exception is 814.290 when operating a vehicle designed to travel with three wheels in contact with the ground at speeds of less than 15 mph.

Hot/Cold Pit Dress Code: Long pants, close toed shoes, shoulders covered.

Camping: Permitted, power is limited availability not guaranteed. No dump station on property. Tent camping permitted. Fires must be contained in a portable and self-contained unit that is propane and designed to be a fire pit off the ground with a flame height less than 4-inches. NO WOOD campfires are allowed.

Waste Disposal: Use of the Safety-Kleen waste drums is mandatory for used oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting material. Located throughout the paddock. **Please do not place any flammables in trash cans or dumpsters.**
