Staging Location: Newly paved lot in Raceplex, located on Raceplex Drive. Trailers will not be able to disconnect in this area.

Cleanliness: It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams

are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.

Paddock Power: Available at VIR receptacles for \$30 fee per plug-in. VIR security will come around to collect fee.

Personal Vehicles: No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you used it to tow your trailer. All street cars must

be parked in designated "STREET CAR PARKING" areas. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the

paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.

RVs: RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer. See paddock power details above.

oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting material. Spillage will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the facility. Participants must remove all used tires, batteries, and unwanted parts. VIR does

not permit Chlorinated Brake Cleaner on property.

Pets: Pets are allowed in the paddock and must be always kept on a leash. No pets allowed on grid or pit lane.


