Length of Circuit/Turns: 2.2 miles/11-turn road course

Race Direction: Counterclockwise

Pole Position: Drivers Left

Start & Finish Line: Pit Straight

Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

Registration: All participants must go to registration paddock.
Wednesday: Lakebed (Please enter via South Boundary Rd.)
Thursday-Sunday: South Boundary Rd.

Grid Location: In the paddock, against turn 10 fence between garages and track exit.

Track Entrance: For those wishing to enter the track once a session has begun, please proceed to “pre-grid” and a marshal will release you.

Race Control Location: Room in the trailer across from the Triple Tower.

Timing & Scoring: Across the track from the Race Control Tower - Driver's right

Stewards' Office: SVRA: Race Control
Trans Am: Series Trailer

Meeting Locations: SVRA: 2nd floor of Newman Building across from the souvenir store
Trans Am: 2nd floor of Newman Building across from the souvenir store

Podium Ceremony: Victory Circle is located near “Center gate”

Black Flag Locations: Turns 7 and Start/Finish

Track Security: Operations Office

Scooters/Bikes: If you leave the paddock on a scooter or motorcycle, California law requires that you wear a helmet; outside the main paddock are public roads.

Hot/Cold Pit Dress Code: Long pants, closed-toed shoes, shoulders covered.

Staging Location: Lakebed, Enter Facility via South Boundary Rd. off Hwy 218 & Gen. Jim Moore. (Do NOT arrive before Tuesday at 8am) Garage Renters look for Garage Lane

Staging Hours: Tuesday April 30th 8am-10pm (Lakebed via South Boundary)

Wednesday, May 1st 7am- 12 pm (Lakebed via South Boundary)

Thursday, May 2nd must register on South Boundary rd. before staging in Lakebed

Load In Begins: Wednesday, May 1st 12:00 pm-6:00 pm

Beginning with Garage Renters from 12:00pm-1:00pm (SVRA/TRANS AM/IGT)

Trans Am: For those participating in the optional Test Thursday: Wednesday, May 1st at 3:00PM-6:00

Load Out: Monday, May 6th at 8 am all vehicles must clear the paddock.

Paddock Power: There is no power in the paddock. Please plan accordingly.

Personal Vehicles: No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock. All street cars must be parked in Blue 2 Lot (just outside the paddock entry) There will be shuttles running from Blue Lot 2 and the Paddock. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the paddock, must be approved for parking pass, please use caution, and observe all fire lanes.

RVs: RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer and fit within the allocated space.
