PADDOCK INFORMATION

Staging Location: Newly paved lot in Raceplex, located on Raceplex Drive. Trailers will not be able to disconnect in this area.

Staging Begins: Wednesday, October 2nd at 12:00 pm for SVRA, Trans Am TA2 entries and GT Classes testing with SVRA.

Wednesday, October 2nd at 7:30 PM for all other Trans Am entries

Load In Begins: SVRA & Eligible Trans Am: Wednesday, October 2nd 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm

Trans Am (TA2 $^{\circ}$ Classes): Wednesday, October 2nd from 3:30 pm - 6:00 pm Trans Am (TA/GT Classes): Thursday October 3rd from 2:00 pm - 3:00 pm

Load Out: Sunday, October 6th by 7:00 pm. Trucks can be parked in the Staging Lot on Raceplex Drive until Monday

morning, but all vehicles must clear the paddock Sunday night.

Cleanliness: It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams

are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.

Paddock Power: Available at VIR receptacles for \$50 fee per plug-in. You should go to your paddock location and security

will be around the next day to collect the fee.

Personal Vehicles: No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you used it to tow your trailer. All street cars must

be parked in designated "STREET CAR PARKING" areas. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the

paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.

RVs: RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer. See paddock power details above.

Waste Disposal: Use of the Safety Kleen waste drums behind the fuel pumps and by the restrooms is mandatory for used

oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting material. Spillage will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the facility. Participants must remove all used tires, batteries, and unwanted parts. VIR does

not permit Chlorinated Brake Cleaner on property.

Pets: Pets are allowed in the paddock and must be always kept on a leash. No pets allowed on grid or pit lane.

Owners must clean up after pets. No pets in any VIR buildings or lodging accommodations.

Personal Pit Vehicles: ATVs, golf carts, pit bikes/scooters, and other off-road style vehicles must be registered with VIR. Each

vehicle must have operable lights, brakes, horn (if so equipped), and be a hand-controlled steering system. Paddock Vehicle Passes are available for \$30 by registering in advance online or \$35 if purchased at the track. Hoverboards or single-wheeled vehicles are not permitted. Passes can be picked up at the

Administration Building on your left on the way into the paddock.

PA for additional information. No motorized vehicles of any kind allowed.






MAPS
