are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.

Paddock Power: Paddock power is extremely limited, and competitors should not expect it. Trailers are not allowed to be

plugged in to the garages.

Personal Vehicles: No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you used it to tow your trailer. All street cars must

be parked in designated "STREET CAR PARKING" areas, primarily Lot A or Lot E. Those taking their tow

vehicle in and out of the paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.

RVs: RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer. RV spots are available for purchase


