## CIRCUIT DETAILS

**Circuit Information:** Sebring International Raceway, 113 Midway Drive, Sebring, FL 33870

**Length of Circuit/Turns:** 3.74 miles/17-turn road course

**Race Direction:** Clockwise

**Pole Position:** Drivers Left

**Start & Finish Line:** Pit Straight

**Pit Lane Speed:** 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

**Registration:** Before entering the facility, all participants must go to Registration at the Sebring Main Office, located to the right of the main gates. Access to Registration will be through the gate across from the staging lanes.

**Grid Location:** Inside Turn 17, all series

**Track Entrance:** For those wishing to enter the track once a session has begun, please proceed to the southern pit lane gate near T17.

**Race Control Location:** Fourth floor of the Race Control Tower/Pit Building

**Timing & Scoring:** Third floor of the Race Control Tower/Pit Building

**Stewards' Office:** SVRA: Race Control  
Trans Am: Series Trailer

**Meeting Locations:** SVRA: Legends Building  
Trans Am: Legends Building

**Podium Ceremony:** Victory Circle is located near T17/Pit In Bridge. See map.

**Black Flag Locations:** Turns 10, 15, and Start/Finish

**Track PA & Broadcast:** 89.9 FM

**Track Security:** See Sebring security at the main gate.

**Scooters/Bikes:** Stick scooters, hoverboards, single-wheeled powered vehicles, and anything else without a factory-installed seat are not allowed.

**RV/Camping:** Designated RV camping is found in Spaces 91-154 where shore power and water are available (see map below). **To reserve a RV space in the RV lot, please contact the SVRA/TA Paddock Director, Jeff Luckritz at [jeff@svra.com](mailto:jeff@svra.com)**  
Race teams take priority for shore power found along the fence. Race Trailer plug-ins with electricity are available on a **First-Come-First-Serve basis**. The cost is **\$100 per connection** (per cord not per outlet box). You must pay for electricity with the track, they will collect at pre-staging, to receive the tag to put on your cord. Water hookups are limited. There is no dump station on the property. Tent camping is permitted. Campfires of any type are not allowed. Men's and Women's showers are located throughout the paddock. No overnight camping in the area outside Registration.

#### **Paddock Information**

**Staging:** Enter through Gate 4 on Carroll Shelby Road and stage in the skid pad lot. Do NOT arrive before Tuesday. Teams arriving after staging has been completed will need to park in this same area, go to Registration, and then enter the Paddock via the bridge.

**Staging Hours:** SVRA: As early as Tuesday, February 18 12:00 pm – 6:00 pm  
Trans Am: Wednesday, February 19 2:00 pm

**Load In:** SVRA: Wednesday, February 19 1:00 pm– 6:00 pm  
Trans Am: See Schedule

**Load Out:** Must clear the paddock Sunday night. If you need to stay over until Monday please move to the “Manufacture Paddock” where the car show was located on “Midway Dr.”

**Concrete Blocks:** Concrete blocks are available from Sebring Raceway for your canopies. The fee is \$40 per block. Contact Matt Muha in advance at [mmuha@sebringraceway.com](mailto:mmuha@sebringraceway.com)

**Quiet Hours:** No race engines between 8:00 pm and 7:00 am.

**Cleanliness:** It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.

**Paddock Power:** (see Circuit Details / RV/Camping section above)

**Personal Vehicles:** No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you use it to tow your trailer. All street cars must be parked in designated “STREET CAR PARKING” areas. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.

**RVs:** RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer.

**NOTE: If ordering fuel by the barrel, you MUST take the barrel with you or you will be charged \$25 each for disposal.**

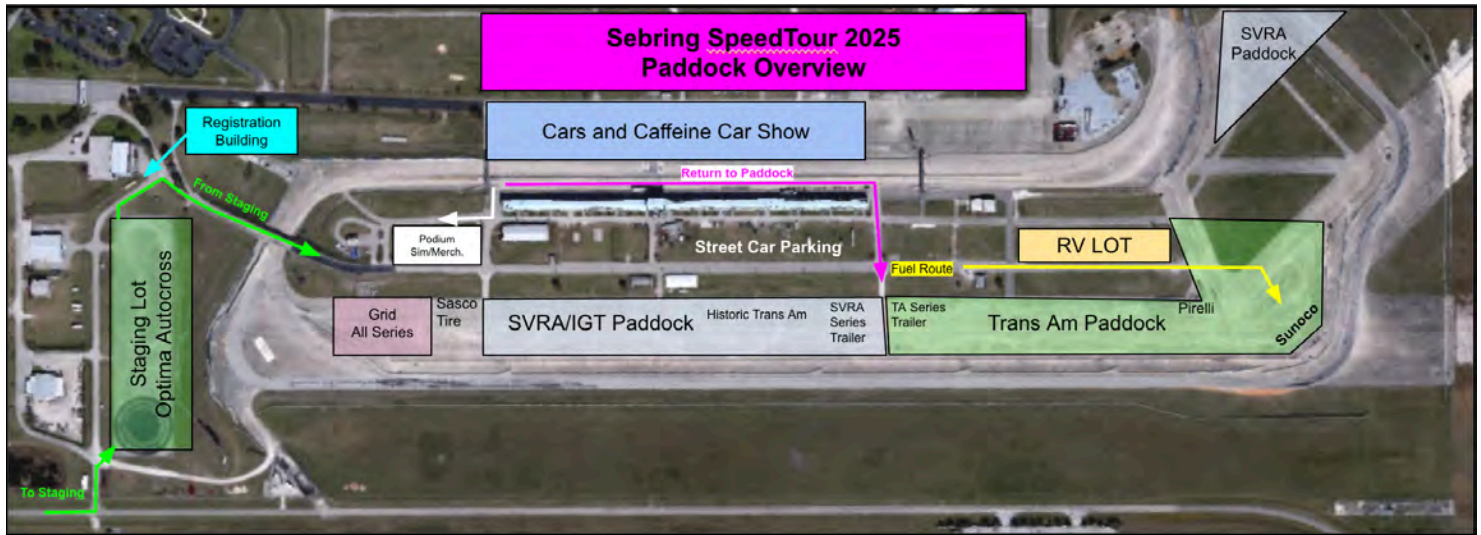
