	box). You must pay for electricity with the track, they will collect at pre-staging, to receive the tag to put		
	on your cord. Water hookups are limited. There is no dump station on the property. Tent camping is		
	permitted. Campfires of any type are not allowed. Men's and Women's showers are located throughout		
	the paddock. No overnight camping in the area outside Registration.
