Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

Registration: Before entering the facility, all participants must go to Registration at the Sebring Main Office, located to

the right of the main gates. Access to Registration will be through the gate across from the staging lanes.

Grid Location: Inside Turn 17, all series

Track Entrance: For those wishing to enter the track once a session has begun, please proceed to the southern pit lane

gate near T17.

Track Security: See Sebring security at the main gate.

Scooters/Bikes: Stick scooters, hoverboards, single-wheeled powered vehicles, and anything else without a

factory-installed seat are not allowed.

RV/Camping: Designated RV camping is found in Spaces 91-154 where shore power and water are available (see map

Race teams take priority for shore power found along the fence. Race Trailer plug-ins with electricity are available on a **First-Come-First-Serve basis**. The cost is **\$100 per connection** (per cord not per outlet box). You must pay for electricity with the track, they will collect at pre-staging, to receive the tag to put on your cord. Water hookups are limited. There is no dump station on the property. Tent camping is permitted. Campfires of any type are not allowed. Men's and Women's showers are located throughout

the paddock. No overnight camping in the area outside Registration.

PADDOCK INFORMATION

Staging: Enter through Gate 4 on Carroll Shelby Road and stage in the skid pad lot. Do NOT arrive before Tuesday.

Teams arriving after staging has been completed will need to park in this same area, go to Registration,

and then enter the Paddock via the bridge.

Concrete Blocks: Concrete blocks are available from Sebring Raceway for your canopies. The fee is \$40 per block.

Personal Vehicles: No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock unless you use it to tow your trailer. All street cars must

be parked in designated "STREET CAR PARKING" areas. Those taking their tow vehicle in and out of the

paddock, please use caution and observe all fire lanes.

RVs: RVs will not be allowed in the paddock unless they are towing a trailer.
