Race Direction: Counterclockwise

Pole Position: Drivers Left

Start & Finish Line: Pit Straight

Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.

Registration: All participants **MUST** go to Registration at the Clubhouse.

Sound Limit: 108db

Grid Location: North of the last set of awnings

Track Entrance: From grid, second opening to hot pit

Race Control Location: 2nd Floor of the Club House/Tower

Timing & Scoring: 2nd Floor of the Club House/Tower

Scooters/Bikes: Unauthorized vehicles including ATV's, golf carts, motorized bikes, scooters, or skateboards are NOT allowed on the racetrack at Thunderhill Park. No one under 16 is allowed on any ATV, golf cart, motorized bike, or scooter.

Camping: Electric hookup available for \$150 for the weekend, please contact Jessie Panel at 888-965-7872 ext 2. Absolutely no water or sewer hook ups. No dump station on property.
Nearest wastewater disposal: Pilot Center in Orland, about 15 min north on Hwy 5.
No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbeques and grills are permitted.

Showers: Located near the center of the paddock in both the East and West paddocks

Waste Disposal: Located near the fuel pumps

Staging:	See attached map. Staging lanes are located at the main entrance off Hwy 162. Upon arrival, please proceed to the furthest right lane and fill it first before filling the middle lane then the left lane.
Staging Hours:	All Series: No earlier than Thursday, October 9th at 12:00 pm
Load In:	All Series: Thursday, October 9th at 5:30 pm – 7:30 pm
Load Out:	Paddock must be cleared Sunday, October 12th at 7:00 pm. If you need to stay overnight Sunday, please return to staging lanes.
Concrete Blocks:	Not available
Quiet Hours:	No race engines can be run before 7:30 am or after 6:00 pm Quiet time is from 10:00 pm – 7:30 am.
Cleanliness:	It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to both the fans and to the track.
Paddock Power:	Electric hookup available for \$150 for the weekend, to reserve please contact Jessie Panel 888-965-7872 ext. 2
Personal Vehicles:	Park your personal vehicles on the west fence of the paddock, along the back straight between turns 11 and 14.

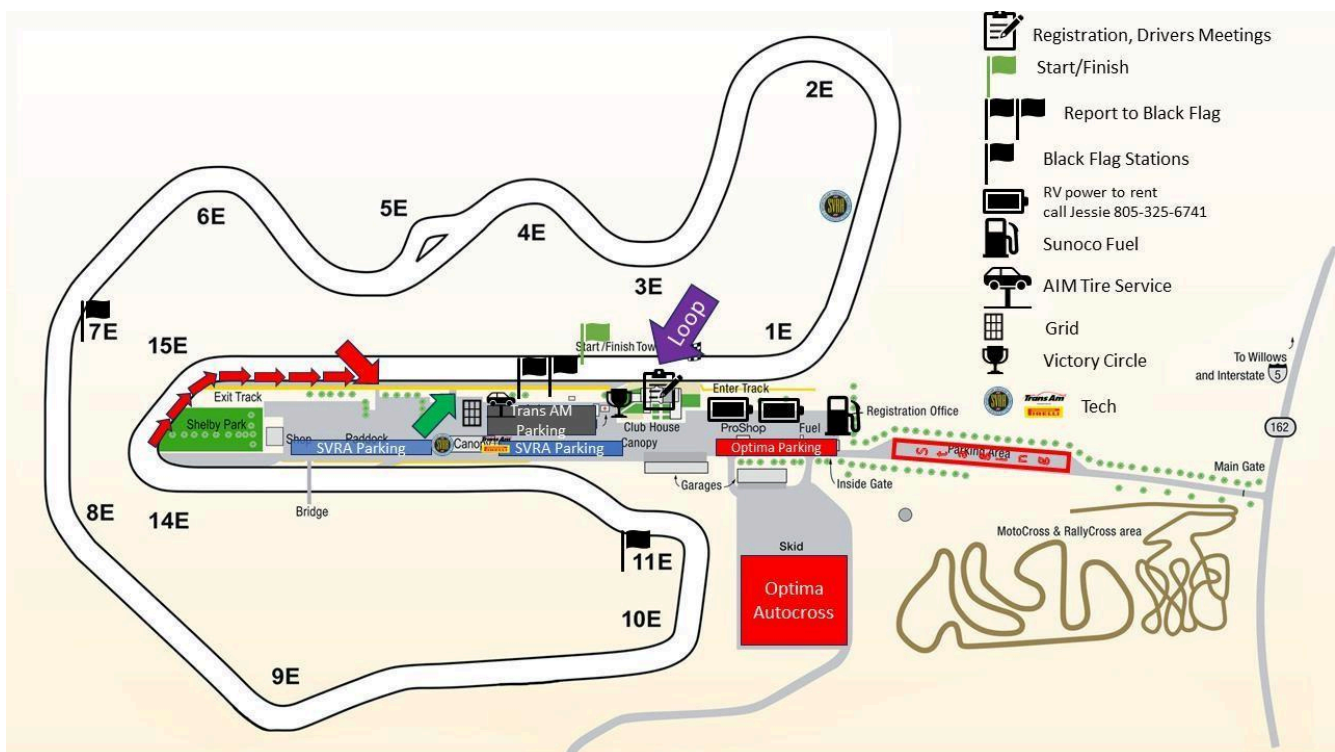
