<b>Length of Circuit/Turns:</b>	2.52 miles/11-turn road course
<b>Race Direction:</b>	Clockwise
<b>Pole Position:</b>	Drivers Left
<b>Start &amp; Finish Line:</b>	Pit Straight
<b>Pit Lane Speed:</b>	40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.
<b>Registration:</b>	Located in the Guest Services Building to the left of the main entry gate. You must register before loading into the paddock.
<b>Grid Location:</b>	Behind the grandstands, please refer to the map included on the last page.
<b>Grid Close time:</b>	<b>The grid closes 5 minutes before session start time. If you arrive late you will start at the back of your group.</b>
<b>Track Entrance:</b>	For those wishing to enter the track once a session has begun: SVRA: Stop by the head of grid (end of the grand stands closest to the media center) to have gear and credentials checked Trans Am: Go directly to Pit Lane. Pit Lane staff will be able to get them on course.

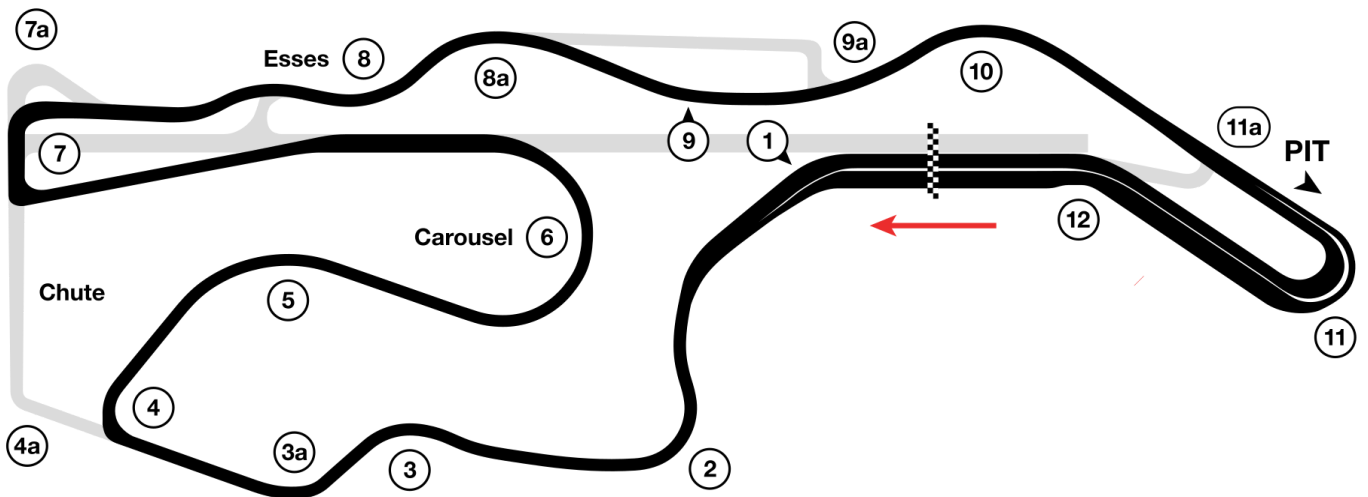

- SVRA Paddock Space:** Paddock spaces will be assigned, 20ft. x 30ft. space per entry.
- Staging Location:** Enter the Facility via the main entrance. Please do not arrive before 1 pm on Tuesday, April 22nd. If arriving before registration opens, please sign the track waiver at the main security shack and proceed to Lot 2 for staging. During registration hours you may stage in front of guest services.
- Staging Hours:** Opens 1pm Tuesday April 22nd - **Please do not arrive before**
- Load-In Begins:** SVRA Wednesday, April 23rd at 1:00 pm (please do not park and leave your vehicle and block traffic)
- Load Out:** Sunday, April 26th at 8 pm. All vehicles must clear the paddock.  
You may stay overnight on Sunday in Lot 2.
- Garages:** **Sold out - contact [info@svra.com](mailto:info@svra.com) to be placed on the waiting list.**

- Cleanliness:** It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris. All teams are expected to present the best possible image to the fans and the track.
- Paddock Power:** There is no power in the paddock, please plan accordingly.
- Personal Vehicles:** No personal vehicles are allowed in the paddock. All street cars must be parked in Lot 2 (just up the hill from the paddock). There will be shuttles available Thursday, 6:30am - 11:30am Friday, Saturday and Sunday starting at 6:30am to end of day. Those taking their tow vehicles in and out of the paddock must be approved for parking pass. Please use caution and observe all fire lanes.
